Kudos to our Christmas party committee for another wonderful job.












































The stylish Model A Ford Sport Coupe was first introduced as one of the six body styles announced by Ford in December 1927. This Model A body style provided the interior appointments of the closed car while appearing, on the outside, as a roadster with a fold-down top. Contributing to the suggestion of the Sport Coupe being a convertible were fixed, non-folding, landau irons positioned behind the side windows. With this appearance, the Sport Coupe is often confused, at first glance, with the Cabriolet – until the Coupe-style sun visor is noticed.
