The History of My 1930 Model A Sport Coupe

Have you ever wondered who originally bought your Model A from a Ford dealer when it was new? I did some research and was able to find out some interesting facts about my car's original owner.

My 1930 Model A Sport Coupe was originally purchased by Mrs. Alice Furness from Thompson-Fauskee Ford located at 17 E. Victoria St. in Santa Barbara on 4/30/1930. I have the original California "Pink Slip" title, picture attached. Alice Furness was born on November 7, 1885 and died on December 21, 1973 at age 88. I purchased the Sport Coupe in 1974 (about a year after Alice died) from a used car dealer on lower State Street in Santa Barbara for \$4,500. I saw the car advertised for sale in Hemmings Motor News.

I did some research into Mrs. Furness' life and found out she was married to Mr. Thomas Furness who died in 1931 at the age of 47. Life expectancy for a man in 1930 was 58, so he died earlier than expected. There were no magic drugs like Penicillin available back then, so life was tough when you got sick. It appears that Alice bought the Model A about a year before her husband died. Maybe she was anticipating her husband death and bought the Model A to be able to drive to work to support herself.

We will never know.....


